### **House Bill 1627**

Bill to deregulate broadband failed in the legislative session. Much the same as the recently successful Illinois legislation, the bill would have specified inputs for costing decisions (e.g. actual fills, FCC depreciation lives, and certain cost of capital). The bill would also have permitted SBC to engage in aggressive winback procedures. There was a Senate resolution that had no impact

## REGULATORY OVERVIEW – Q2 2003



***In the Matter of the Review of Ameritech Ohio's TELRIC Costs for Unbundled Network Elements and 271: Application by SBC Communications Inc., Ameritech Ohio, and Ameritech Long Distance for Provision of In-Region, InterLATA Services in Ohio***  
Joint CLECs filed application for rehearing of PUCO's March 13, 2003 entry that "resolved" issues relative to existing UNE-P and new UNE combinations. The entry further stated that CLECs seeking to avail themselves the UNE-P, UNE combinations and special access to EEL conversion as modified by the entry should do so within the context of an interconnection agreement or an amendment to an existing agreement.

### **02-3207-AU-PWC**

Legislature gave the PUCO jurisdiction over municipal right of way fees. This is a joint complaint by various CLECs challenging the ordinance established by the City of Toledo. PUCO Order stated that the ordinance rate was unreasonable. PUCO interpreted the statute as stating that the PUCO does not have the authority to establish or adjust the ordinance rate.
